

## March 17, 2021 Granville Arts Boosters Meeting Minutes

Andy called the meeting to order and thanked the committee for the effort put into the 3/10 Volunteer Town Hall

### Treasurer's Report

- In Shelly's absence, Dawn shared the summary that Shelly had provided. The Boosters received matching checks from Frontstream (\$152.58), Amazon (\$118.90) Kroger (\$349.07) and Just Write (\$150.)
- Andy informed the committee that no additional payment would be due for stadium as previously thought.

### Volunteer Outreach

- Courtney sent an email to members with a link to the volunteer town hall presentation.
- Courtney shared feedback from a member of the Arts Boosters that it was hard to know when meetings happen so the committee discussed better ways to communicate to members. Currently meetings are shared via the Facebook page and occasionally in the school newsletter.
- After some discussion, the group decided to hold the remaining meetings for this school year in person.
- We decided that Dawn would send out an email to the Booster group inviting them of the meeting and ask the Directors to remind parents about the meeting as well.
- Given that we are approaching the end of the year, we discussed using part of the meeting to solicit volunteers for Fall Booster activities. Dawn will update the Town Hall presentation to reflect those immediate needs to share at the next meeting. Pam also suggested making sure that we introduce Board Members.
